

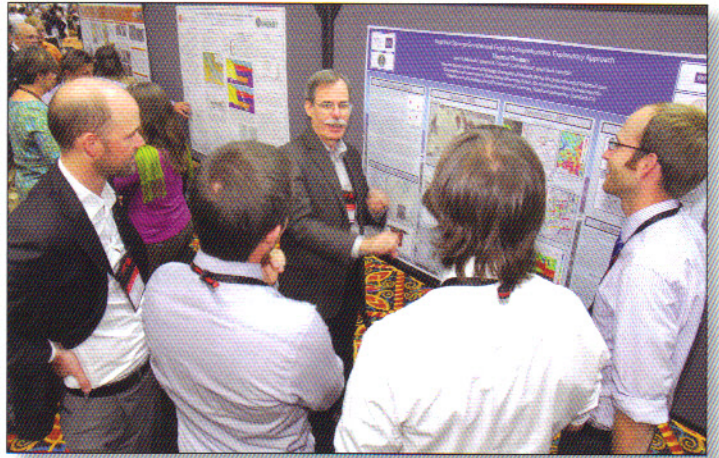

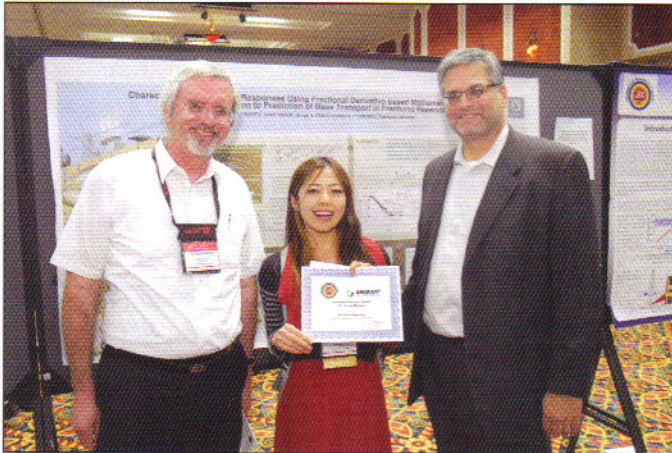

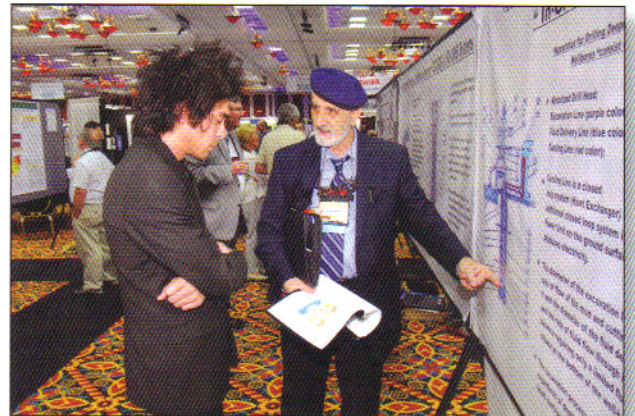

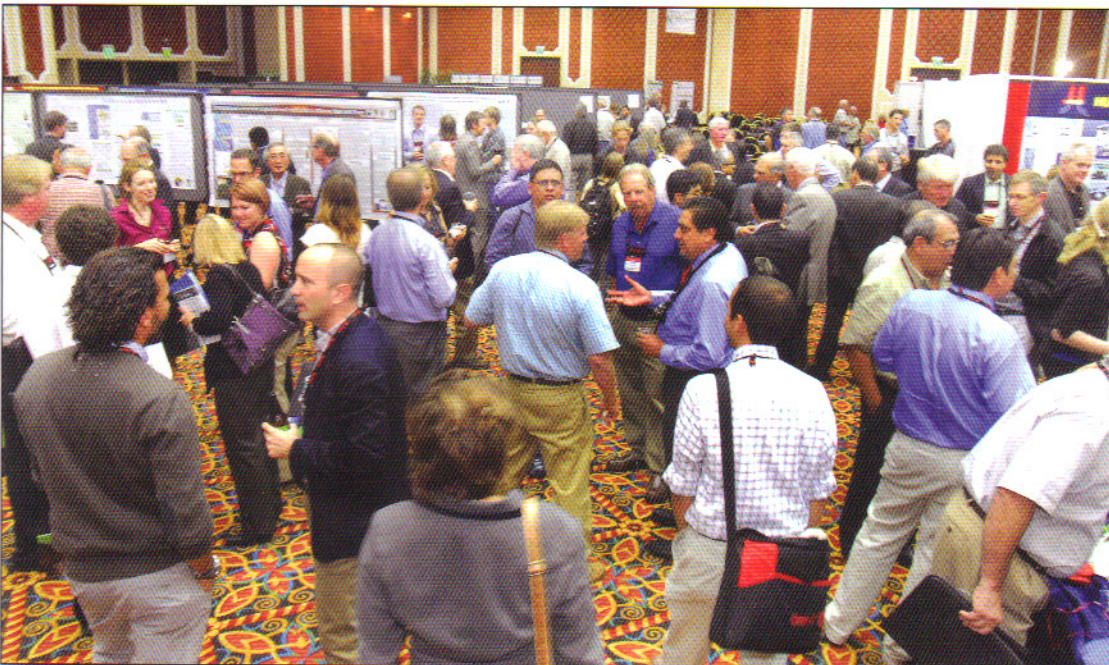
Bill Cumming lead a lively discussion in front of one of the posters.
